



## Installing The SharePoint Shepherd's Guide for End Users: 2013

**Purpose:** Adding The SharePoint Shepherd's Guide for End Users: 2013 to your site collection for use.

### Steps:

1. Click the SPShepherdSetup.exe to launch the "The SharePoint Shepherd's Guide for End Users: 2013" installer. The installer welcome wizard will open.
2. Click Next to begin installation.
3. In the SharePoint Site URL field, enter the location to which you would like to install The SharePoint Shepherd's Guide for End Users: 2013.
4. Enter a name for the library where The SharePoint Shepherd's Guide for End Users: 2013 Wiki files will be located. By default, the name will be "SharePoint Shepherds Guide for End Users," but it can be titled anything you would like.
5. It's suggested that you leave the box next to Generate Table of Contents checked so that the table of contents is automatically created in your SharePoint Site Collection. Uncheck if you have another method you would like to use.
6. In the Select a folder containing the Wiki Content files field, the default file location for the wiki files will be indicated. If you have changed the original file location of all the wiki files content, select the proper location by clicking the ellipsis control and navigating to the correct folder location. If you haven't changed the original file location, click Next.
7. Enter a name for the library where The SharePoint Shepherd's Guide for End Users: 2013 Video files will be located. By default the name will be "SharePoint Shepherds Guide Videos", but it can be titled anything you would like.
8. In the Select a folder containing the Video content files field, the default file location for the video files will be indicated. If you have changed the original file location of all the video file content, select the proper location by clicking the ellipsis control and navigating to the correct folder location. If you haven't changed the original file location, click Next.
9. The installer will now automatically create the content libraries for your wiki and video files.
10. Once your content has been uploaded, click Next.
11. On the Congratulations page, review the number of items successfully deployed, the number of warnings that occurred, and the number of errors that occurred, if any. Follow the file location given in the installer if complications occurred.
12. The installer can be run again at any time to upgrade or repair any file locations.  
When finished, click Finish and your content will be ready for use from the designated site collection.
